WORLD WOMAN FOUNDATION LAUNCHES GLOBAL GENDER HARMONY MOVEMENT IN ARKANSAS

Sept. 30, 2017, Little Rock, Ark. - Hundreds of community and company leaders will meet at the Clinton Presidential Center on Saturday, Sept. 30, for the inaugural World Woman Summit, a day-long event focused on gender harmony. International, national and local activists will discuss ways to accelerate women in leadership roles and ways that women can contribute to the World Woman Foundation's Sustainable Development Goals 2030. These speakers will show their work and other initiatives that are improving the lives of women around the world.

The conference tracks for this sold-out event are Economic Development, Social Entrepreneurship, Global Health Equity, and Violence Against Women. Keynote speakers are Chief Strategy Officer for the National Council on Aging Anna Maria Chavez, Hollywood actress Erin Gavin, global body language expert Linda Clemons, former Director of FEMA under President Bill Clinton James Lee Witt, and founder of Sayfty Dr. Shruti Kapoor.
